Safer Halloween - Expressions of interest



The Community Development Office will be supporting Community Safer Halloween activities being undertaken in 2024. Activities will be led by local voluntary Community groups and Centres on the lead up to and include Halloween eve. Suggested activities will range from diversionary activities including discos, pumpkin carving, mask making, parades etc and will include a 'Stay Safe and Awareness' element. Projects are encouraged to adopt or promote a climate friendly approach to Halloween. The maximum funding available to groups will be €750. Community and voluntary groups are invited to register their interest to host an event. Only groups that have expressed an interest can progress to submitting an application for funding. Community Centre's Investment Fund



The Dept. of Rural and Community Affairs have launched the 2024 Community Centre Investment Fund.

It provides funding for investments in Community Centres in order that these vital services remain useable, accessible, and safe and continue to meet the needs of the community into the future. In the 2022 round, Fingal Community Centres were granted over €600k in funding through the scheme, covering projects ranging from full refurbishments to energy efficiency works.
