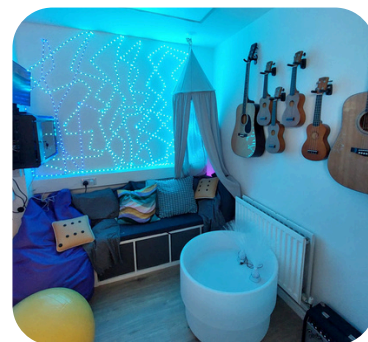

# Spotlight on...Mourne Estate Community Centre



The Mourne Estate Community Centre, built in 2023 and refurbished in 2024 by Fingal County Council, provides a range of facilities for the surrounding community of Skerries.

The centre is managed by Foroige who provide a wide range of supports and services to young people living in the local community to enable them to involve themselves consciously and actively in their own development and the development of society. Foroige also work with local groups and clubs through the provision of meeting rooms at the centre. Mourne Estate Football Club also have changing facilities located on site.

Mourne Estate Community Centre is open seven days a week, depending on demand, and caters for a wide range of youth activities. The centre is a positive hub for the community of Skerries encouraging the community to engage in:

- Youth development - wide range of supports and services provided by Foroige for the young people in the Skerries area.
- Sport - a gym on site with varied equipment available for use.
- Leisure - a space within the centre available with a pool table , games , television for any Foroige members to come and avail of.
- Community Development - Foroige offers services to encourage the young people in the area to encourage them to have a positive affect in the local area.
